Guidelines and User Agreement

Welcome to a Pennsylvania Parent-Child Interaction Therapy (PCIT) listserv hosted by the Early Childhood Innovations Center! Please take a moment to review the guidelines and user agreement below before you begin using this resource.

The mission and purpose is to create an email exchange where PCIT therapists, supervisors, and stakeholders can share information related to early childhood emotional and behavioral health and well-being and PCIT in Pennsylvania (PA). Suggested items for posting would include:

- Community events focusing on the health and well-being of young children & families, where it may be possible to provide a PCIT exhibit table.
- Professional Conferences (state-wide, regional and local)
- PCIT clinical trainings
- Open job positions for PCIT therapists & PCIT Level 1 trainers
- Seeking referral options for PCIT
- PCIT professional journal articles
- Public news or announcements featuring PCIT

Please note that if you are seeking clinical consultation for providing PCIT, we recommend that you talk with your supervisor and/or PCIT trainer first. Please also consider posting on the PCIT International listserv for Certified therapists and Trainers or the UC Davis PCIT listserv. The PA PCIT listserv will focus on sharing information related to the implementation of PCIT in PA and will not provide clinical consultation.

Responding to Messages on the Listserv

To respond to a message posted to the listserv, press “Reply” in your email platform and type your response.

NOTE: The listserv is set up to respond to all members by default. If you wish to send a message to only one person, please ensure that only their address is listed when sending your response.

Unsubscribe from the Listserv

To unsubscribe from The Early Childhood Innovations Center Listserv, with a gmail account, please click on “unsubscribe.” With another type of email account, please send an email to PAPCIT+unsubscribe@ecinnovations.org from the email address from which you wish to unsubscribe.

Listserv Rules and Guidelines

1. The Early Childhood Innovations Center promotes an inclusive environment that respects diversity and welcomes individuals from all backgrounds regardless of race, ethnicity, religious beliefs, gender identification or sexual orientation. Hurtful language toward or about others will result in removal from the listserv.
2. The listserv may not be used as a forum for illegal purposes, including but not limited to defamation, violation of intellectual property laws, violation of antitrust or unfair competition laws or violation of criminal laws. This includes transmission of manuals and forms created by Dr. Sheila Eyberg, PCIT International, and other copyrighted material created by scholars, researchers, and developers of PCIT.
3. Do not intentionally interfere with or disrupt other listserv members, network services, or network equipment. This includes distribution of unsolicited advertisement or chain letters, propagation of computer viruses, and use of the network to make unauthorized entry to any other machine accessible via the listserv.
4. The listserv may not be used for electioneering (e.g., campaigning, solicitation of support), promotion of political actions (e.g., boycotts, letters suggesting legislation), personal fundraising activities, advertising professional services other than PCIT, or for any other personal or monetary profit/gain or other commercial purposes. The staff and consultants of The Early Childhood Innovations Center, LLC, reserve the right to post information regarding training or products relevant to the community. Other listserv members are discouraged from posting messages for which the primary purpose is to advance the business or financial interests of a person or entity other than The Early Childhood Innovations Center. Examples of prohibited communications include advertisements for products or services, notices regarding rental of office space, direct solicitations of listserv members to purchase products or services, and postings that include links to unapproved sites such as political or commercial sites. Examples of messages that may be of financial benefit to listserv members but are not prohibited because they do not contribute to the financial benefit of the author, include news of job listings or position openings, or discussion of professionally-related products or services where the listserv member conveying the information is not in the business of selling the products or services.

Announcements that provide useful professional information to list members but may also have some incidental commercial benefit to the sender (e.g., an author who is a listserv member merely advising the list of publication of a professional book) typically would not be "commercial" for purposes of this restriction.

5. Do not post messages containing information that is defamatory, abusive, profane, threatening, offensive, or illegal.

6. Maintain client confidentiality when seeking referral options.
